Sara Jaber is a Senior Sustainability Engineer at EcoConsulting since 2011 working on BREEAM and LEED assessments, as well as other eco-building services including thermal modelling. She has been involved in over 40 projects in Lebanon and abroad ranging from small residential houses to large developments, comprising BREEAM Excellent and LEED Gold assessments.

Sara holds a MEng in Applied Energy and a BEng of Mechanical Engineering from the American University of Beirut. She is also a LEED Accredited Professional and a Certified Energy Manager.

Sara was selected for two years in a row as a Future Energy Leader of Lebanon by the World Energy Council as part of its FELL18 program, which she presented at the Beirut Energy Forum in 2019.

Sara participates as a Group Coordinator (for Indoor Environmental Quality) in the Technical Committee for the development of the standard for Building Environmental Performance with LIBNOR. She also participated in developing the Criteria for Green Buildings in Lebanon, published by the OEA, which she presented as the Built It Green Lebanon conference in 2015.

As part of the EcoConsulting team, Sara participated in founding The Circular Hub, an eco-friendly learning space about a wide range of topics ranging from the environment & the circular economy to sustainability issues, climate change as well as eco & social entrepreneurship. She has been a lecturer about eco-buildings since 2013 with EcoConsulting and now continues to develop and provide workshops at The Circular Hub.
